## Abound WordUp word of the week: USUAL

<u>How was this word chosen?</u> This is an academic word, the kind of word that takes *lots* of exposures to learn, and that children will need to know to read texts successfully in the years to come.

Here are 3 more questions to ask about this week's word, **USUAL** (**USUAL** definition: what you do most of the time, what you eat regularly):

How often do you think you have to go to a restaurant to be able to say, "The USUAL, please," and have the waitress know what you want??
- My USUAL morning routine is to brush my teeth then take a shower, but I'm trying to make exercise part
  of my USUAL routine now, and so my routine is feeling UNUSUAL! Do you like making exercise part of
  your USUAL routine during the day?
