- This week's academic vocabulary word is OCCUR. Here are 2 ways to give your child extra opportunities to hear and use the word OCCUR!
 - What weather OCCURS during the wintertime that you really like? Is there any weather that OCCURS during winter that you don't like?
 - ♦ Now that I'm making tea it just **OCCURRED** to me that I forgot to get milk at the store! Ugh. Why do you think it just **OCCURRED** to me now?
 - Remind your child that the word **OCCUR** means to happen, or it can also mean to be thought of by someone.
- How else can you build your child's reading skills through TALK?
 - Try these questions taken from different TalkOn age groups this week!
 - Mountain lions are also called cougars and panthers, but scientists call them pumas. How many sounds can we hear in the word puma? (Four). Can we name any of the letters that make those sounds?
 - ◆ If you were hiking a mountain and you had the choice of a longer trail with more beautiful sights along the way, or a trail that was shorter and got you to the top more quickly, which would you choose? Why?
 - ◆ Chair lifts are open-air benches with safety bars that carry skiers up the mountain. If you were on one, and your seat mate was making the chair rock back and forth, what would you do?
