- **This week's academic vocabulary word is JUSTIFY.** Here are 2 ways to give your child extra opportunities to hear and use the word **JUSTIFY**!
  - ◆ *If your brother or sister took money from you to buy themselves something, would you think they were **JUSTIFIED** in taking the money? What if they used your money to buy groceries for someone who was hungry and didn't have any money? Then are they **JUSTIFIED**?*
  - ◆ *If you get money for doing your chores, do you think you are **JUSTIFIED** in spending it any way you want to?*
    - *Remind your child that the word **JUSTIFY** means to have a good reason for something.*
- **How else can you build your child's reading skills through TALK?**
  - Try these questions taken from different TalkOn age groups this week!
    - ◆ *If you **lend** money, the person should pay you back. What word do you get when you add a B to the beginning of the word **lend**? (blend) What word is left when you take the L out of that new word? (bend)*
    - ◆ *Some people make a point of giving a percentage of the money they earn to **charity**, organizations that help those in need. How do you know when you have enough money and can give some to **charity**?*
    - ◆ *If you go to the movies with a friend and you **treat**, that means you pay for the friend's ticket. Who would you **treat** if you had the money? Has anyone ever **treated** you?*
